

Sovereignty Defined



- The highest position in a dominion or domain
 - King in an autocracy
 - Sovereign nation

Sovereignty Defined




- The highest position in a dominion or domain
 - Implies there is no higher position
 - Implies ultimate authority
 - Implies the power to sustain

Sovereignty Defined



- The highest position in a dominion or domain
 - Does not define character
 - Does not provide a full view of who God revealed Himself to be
 - Does not elaborate purpose and will

Sovereignty Declared



- Ps 22:28 ..for dominion belongs to the LORD and He rules over the nations..
- Ps 115:1 Not to us, O LORD, not to us but to your name be the glory, because of your love and faithfulness.
 - 2 Why do the nations say, "Where is their God?"
 - 3 Our God is in heaven; he does whatever pleases him.
- · Mat 6:9 Our Father in heaven, your will be done on earth, as it is in heaven...

Sovereignty Declared




- Isaiah 46:9 Remember the former things, those of long ago; I am God, and there is no other; I am God, and there is none like me.
- 10 I make known the end from the beginning, from ancient times, what is still to come. I say: My purpose will stand, and I will do all that I please.
- 11 .. What I have said, that will I bring about; what I have planned, that will I do.
- John 17:2 For you granted him authority over all people that He might give eternal life to all those you have given Him.

Sovereignty Declared OT

- Dan 4:34 At the end of that time, I, Nebuchadnezzar, raise my eyes towards heaven, and my sanity was restored. Then I praised the Most High; I honoured and glorified him who lives for ever. His dominion is an eternal dominion; his kingdom endures from generation to generation.
- 35 All the peoples of the earth are regarded as nothing. He does as he pleases with the powers of heaven and the peoples of the earth. No-one can hold back his hand or say to him: "What have you done?"
- 36 At the same time that my sanity was restored, my honour and splendour were returned to me for the glory of my kingdom. My advisers and nobles sought me out, and I was restored to my throne and became even greater than before.
- 37 Now I, Nebuchadnezzar, praise and exalt and glorify the King of heaven, because everything he does is right and all his ways are just. And those who walk in pride he is able to humble.

Sovereignty Declared



- Ezekiel 21:25 "O profane and wicked prince of Israel, whose day has come, whose time of punishment has reached its climax,
- 26 this is what the Sovereign LORD says: Take off the turban, remove the crown. It will not be as it was: The lowly will be exalted and the exalted will be brought low.
- 27 A ruin! A ruin! I will make it a ruin! It will not be restored until he comes to whom it rightfully belongs; to him I will give it.'
- 28 ¶ "And you, son of man, prophesy and say, 'This is what the Sovereign LORD says about the Ammonites and their insults: "A sword, a sword, drawn for the slaughter, polished to consume and to flash like lightning!

Sovereignty Declared by Jesus



· Mt 23:37 "O Jerusalem, Jerusalem, you who kill the prophets and stone those sent to you, how often I have longed to gather your children together, as a hen gathers her chicks under her wings, but you were not willing.

Sovereignty Declared by Jesus

- John 10: 24 The Jews gathered round him, saying, "How long will you keep us in suspense? If you are the Christ, tell us plainly."
- 25 Jesus answered, "I did tell you, but you do not believe. The miracles I do in my Father's name speak for me,
- · 26 but you do not believe because you are not my sheep.
- 27 My sheep listen to my voice; I know them, and they follow me.
- 28 I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish;
 no-one can snatch them out of my hand.
- 29 My Father, who has given them to me, is greater than all; no-one can snatch them out of my Father's hand.
- 30 I and the Father are one."

 - Food (Feeding the crowds)

Sovereignty Demonstrated in Jesus


- Over Principalities and Powers

- The Lord has made everything for its own purpose, even the wicked for the day of evil. (Prov 16:4)





- Paying of taxes to the Kings of the earth






Sovereignty Demonstrated in Jesus

- · In the salvation of the elect
 - Joh 6:40 For my Father's will is that everyone who looks to the Son and believes in him shall have eternal life, and I will raise him up at the last day.
 - John 6:44 No-one can come to me unless the Father who sent me draws him, and I will raise him up at the last day.

Sovereignty Demonstrated in Jesus

In the salvation of the elect

- Joh 15:16 You did not choose me, but I chose you and appointed you to go and bear fruit—fruit that will last. Then the Father will give you whatever you ask in my name.
- Eph 1:4 For he chose us in him before the creation of the world to be holy and blameless in his sight. In love he predestined us to be adopted as his sons through Jesus Christ, in accordance with his pleasure and will—
- Eph 1:13 And you also were included in Christ when you heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation. Having believed, you were marked in him with a seal, the promised Holy Spirit,

- Rom 9:11 Yet, before the twins were born or had done anything good or bad—in order that God's purpose in election might stand:
- 12 not by works but by him who calls—she was told, "The older will serve the younger."
- 13 Just as it is written: "Jacob I loved, but Esau I hated."
- 14 ¶ What then shall we say? Is God unjust? Not at all!
- 15 For he says to Moses, "I will have mercy on whom I have mercy, and I will have compassion on whom I have compassion."
- 16 It does not, therefore, depend on man's desire or effort, but on God's mercy.
- 17 For the Scripture says to Pharaoh: "I raised you up for this very purpose, that I might display my power in you and that my name might be proclaimed in all the earth."
- 18 Therefore God has mercy on whom he wants to have mercy, and he hardens whom he wants to harden.
- 19 One of you will say to me: "Then why does God still blame us? For who resists his will?"
- 20 But who are you, O man, to talk back to God? "Shall what is formed say to him who formed it, 'Why did you make me like this?'
- Ro 10:9 That if you confess with your mouth, "Jesus is Lord," and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved.

Questions that arise

Why did He choose Israel as the nation as His own people?

Why did Jesus heal some and not all? Why did He rise only Lazarus from the dead?

How can God be Almighty and Good with all the suffering in the world?

Why does he let this happen to me?

Why does He save so few?

What are the implications?

Produces humility before our Lord (Thomas my Lord & my God)

Prompts us to deep respect and awe (The official & household believed)

Determines the conditions of our relationship with God (You must be born again)

Strengthens our faith (To Martha Whoever believes in me will never die)

Leads to contentment (My sheep listen to my voice)

Draws us to worship
