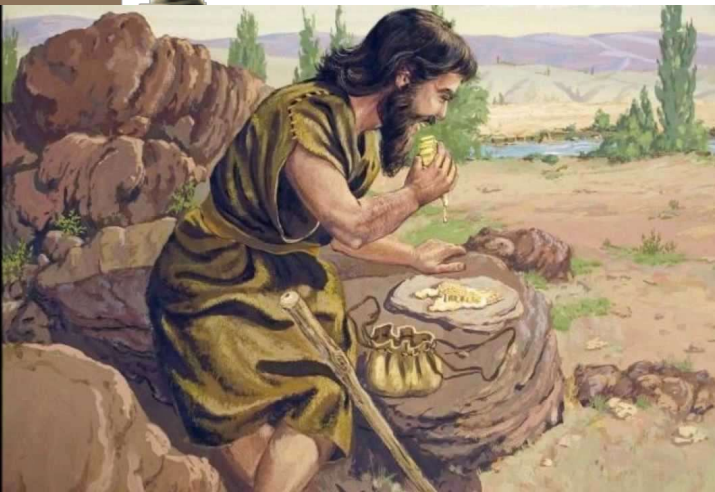

***Preparatory** Matt 3:9 *The axe is already at the root*

of the trees, and every tree that does not produce good fruit will be cut down and thrown into the fire."

10 *"What should we do then?" the crowd asked.*

11 *John answered, "The man with two tunics should share with him who has none, and the one who has food should do the same."*

12 *Tax collectors also came to be baptised. "Teacher," they asked, "what should we do?"*

13 *"Don't collect any more than you are required to," he told them.*

14 *Then some soldiers asked him, "And what should we do?" He replied, "Don't extort money and don't accuse people falsely— be content with your pay."*

15 ¶ *The people were waiting expectantly and were all wondering in their hearts if John might possibly be the Christ.*

16 *John answered them all, "I baptise you with water. But one more powerful than I will come, the thongs of whose sandals I am not worthy to untie. He will baptise you with the Holy Spirit and with fire.*

17 *His winnowing fork is in his hand to clear his threshing-floor and to gather the wheat into his barn, but he will burn up the chaff with unquenchable fire."*
