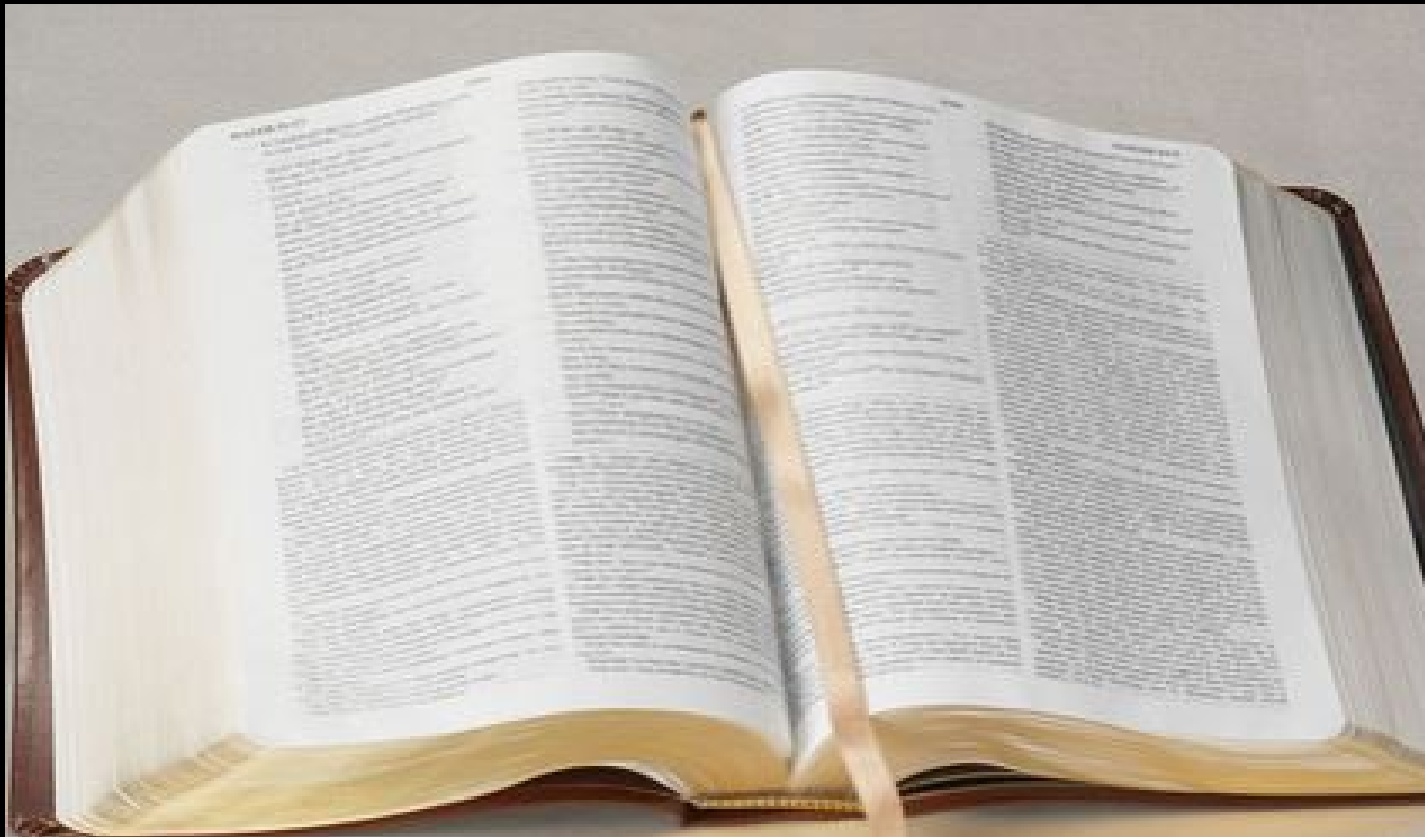


Living Bread- Jn. 6: 35, 41, 48-51

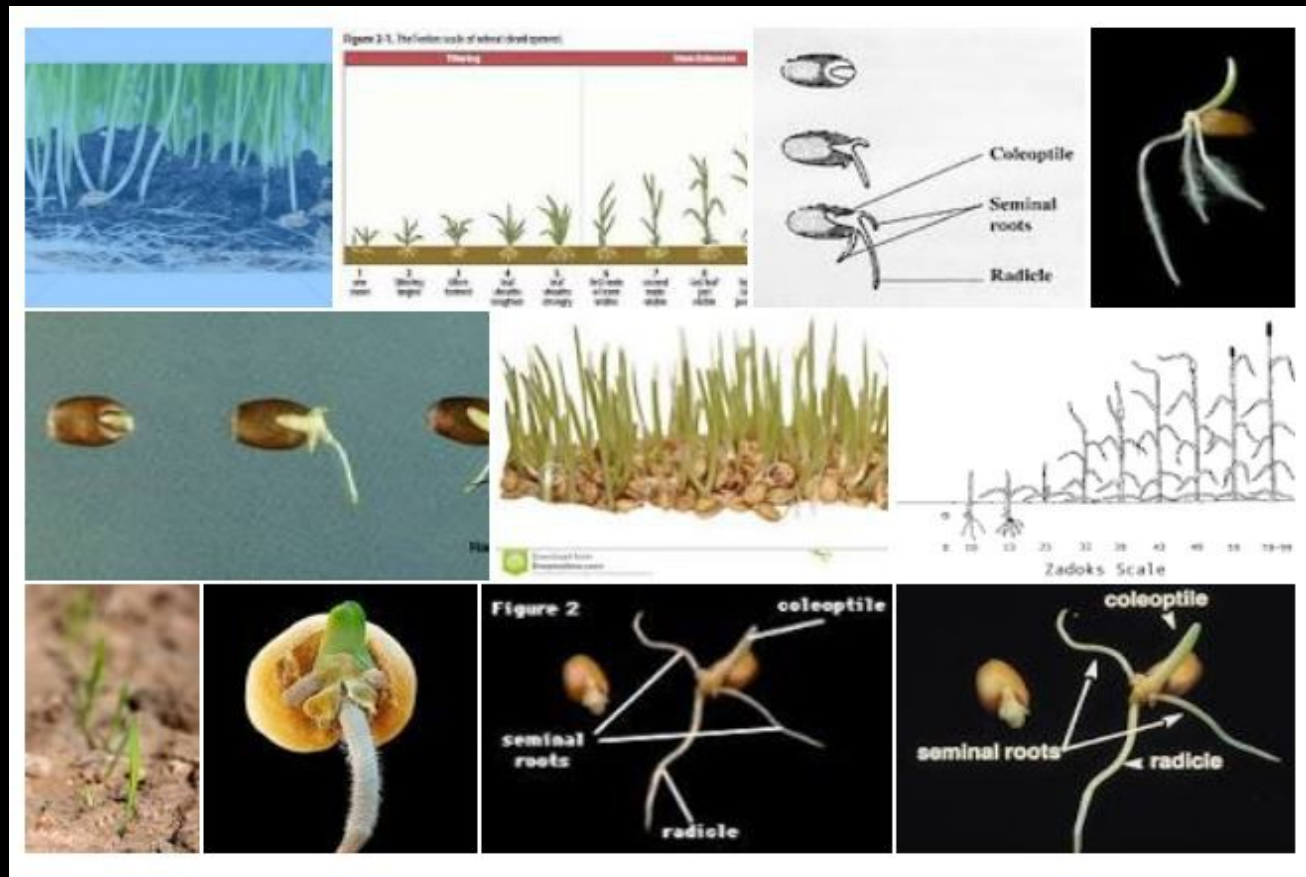
Part #4. The Setting in the Synagogue- Jn. 6:26-35

Jesus answered them and said, "Most assuredly, I say to you, you seek Me, not because you saw the signs, but because you ate of the bread and were amply filled. 27 Do not labor for the food which perishes, but for the food which abides into everlasting life, which the Son of Man will give you, because God the Father has set His seal on Him." 28 Then they said to Him, "What shall we create, that we may work the works of God?" 29 Jesus answered and said to them, "This is the work of God, that you have faith into Him, whom He sent." 30 Therefore they said to Him, "What sign will You perform then, that we may see it and believe You? What work will You do? 31 Our fathers ate the manna in the desert; as it is written, 'He gave them bread out from heaven to eat.' 32 Then Jesus said to them, "Most assuredly, I say to you, Moses did not give you the bread out from heaven, but My Father gives you the true bread out from heaven. 33 For the bread of God is He who has descended down out from heaven and has given life to the world." 34 Then they said to Him, "Lord, give us this bread always. 35 And Jesus said to them, "I am the bread of life. He that accompanies Me shall never ever hunger, and he who trusts into Me shall never ever thirst.

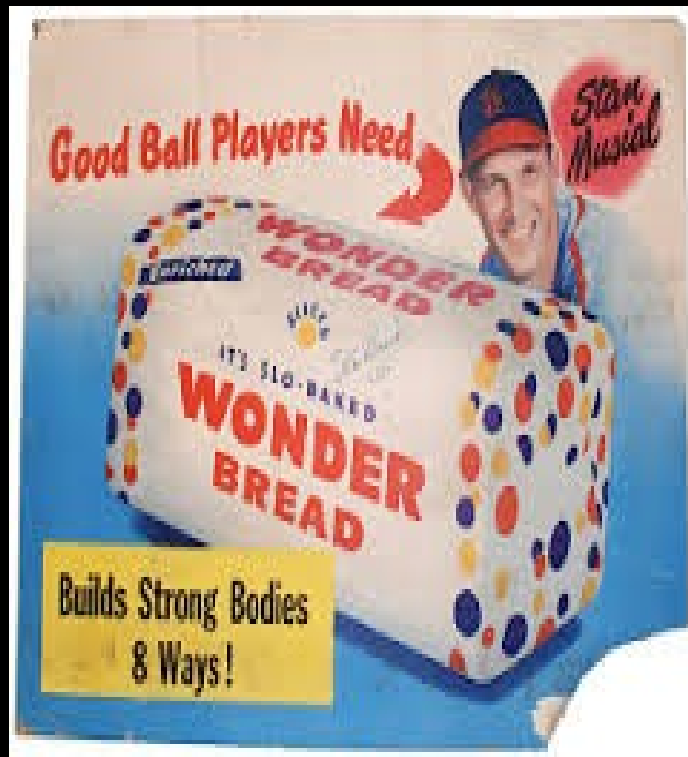
